CONNECT (BUILD RELATIONSHIPS)

1. Do you have a favourite Bible verse that is particularly meaningful to you? Why?
2. Is there a specific Bible version or translation that you enjoy?
3. Has there ever been a time when you recalled a scripture that you've memorized and found it practically helped you? Explain.

THRIVE (EXPLORE BIBLICAL TRUTH)

4. Read Psalm 119:105 and Hebrews 4:12. Discuss the connection between these two verses.
5. Read 2 Timothy 3:16-17. What words or phrases immediately stand out to you? What do these verses tell us regarding the value of scripture in our lives?
6. Read Psalm 18:30. In what ways can the Word of God be a "shield" or "refuge"?

7. Read Psalm 119:130. Discuss what this scripture is saying to us.

COMMIT (BE ON MISSION)

8. Read the verse below from Psalm 119 three times slowly and spend a few moments meditating on it in silence.
9. Choose a portion of scripture this week and commit to memorizing it.
10. Who is one person you might consider inviting to church during this teaching series?
11. What ways are you seeking to follow Jesus as your model?
