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## CONNECT (BUILD RELATIONSHIPS)

1. Has there ever been a time when you felt like an outsider in a specific place or situation?
2. What sins do you think we, as flawed people, have the hardest time forgiving or responding to with grace?
3. Who would you be most surprised by if they came to faith in Christ?

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## THRIVE (EXPLORE BIBLICAL TRUTH)

4. Read John 4:1–26. What had the Pharisees heard about Jesus and why do you think it influenced Jesus to make the decision he did in verse 3?
5. Jesus talks quite a bit about “living water” in the first part of this chapter. Living water is literally a description of running water as opposed to still water, as would be found in a well. What do you think that Jesus is trying to get at in verses 10–15 by talking about “living water”? You may also want to read John 1:17–18; 1:32–34; and 7:37–39.
6. Jesus points out that with His coming the geographical centre of worship is no longer important, whether Mount Gerizim or Mount Zion. Instead, according to Jesus, God is looking for something else. What is it as seen in verses 21–24? What does this mean?

7. How would you describe the life of the Samaritan woman after her conversation with Jesus (verse 26 onward)? What did she do? How had she changed?

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## COMMIT (BE ON MISSION)

8. Is there someone in your life that seems far away from Jesus that you could pray would have an encounter with him? Stop and ask Jesus to reveal himself to them.
9. We all have known and unknown prejudices in our hearts against certain people for many different reasons. How could this story help us overcome these obstacles?
10. What is one practical thing you can do this week to live as a worshiper of God in spirit and truth with rivers of living water welling up from your life? Write it down and reflect on it through the week. If you are in a Home Group, discuss this with one another.
